**Worship: Warren Sullivan**

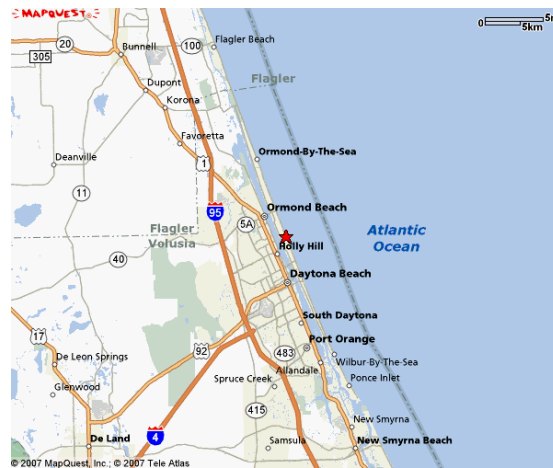
